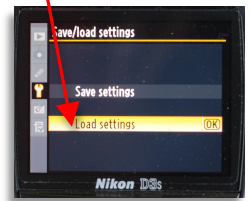

Nikon Button Tour

Nikon Button Tour is a post-photo session reset

The idea behind the ***Nikon Button Tour*** is simple. When you're finished taking photos for the day if you reset your camera settings you won't get caught with incorrect settings on your next photo outing.

Save/Load Settings

At the start of a photo session select > **Set Up Menu (D300, D300s, D700 and D3 cameras)** > **Save/Load Settings** > **Save** > **OK**. This feature writes a bin file to the memory card of the various **Menu** settings. At the end of the day during the Button Tour, select > **Save/Load Settings** > **Load** > **OK**. This will reload the menu settings. If you reformat the memory card the bin file will be deleted.

Set Picture Controls

Shooting Menu

Standard – Recommended for general photography and for images that will have minimal post-processing. Moderate sharpening and saturation increases for balanced results.

Neutral – Ideal for images that will be extensively processed.

Vivid – Nature or landscape photography. Highest contrast, sharpening and saturation settings of the three color Picture Controls. Avoid using this control for people photography.

Monochrome – Use for Black and white photography.

Active D-Lighting – Turn on for shadow areas that need to be lightened/recovered.
